


Christmas Wishes from the Executive

On Oct. 2, 2012 The International Association of Business Communicators Canada (IABC Canada) has announced that John Larsen, ABC, of Calgary is

the 2012 recipient of its prestigious Master Communicator Award. This is IABC Canada's highest honour, and recognizes lifetime achievement in the communications field.

He also held senior communications positions in government, including Regional Director of the National Defence Public Affairs office in Calgary, and is currently in charge of the Canadian Forces Public Affairs Branch Primary Reserve. He has developed issues management programs and plans for high-profile events, including security communications for the 2008 Beijing and 2010 Vancouver Olympics.

The IABC Master Communicator designation is the association's highest honour in Canada. It recognizes outstanding career achievements; contributions to the communications profession; thought leadership, teaching and writing in communications; service and leadership in IABC; and overall contributions to the community. IABC Canada has honoured only 43 individuals with this designation since it was established in 1980. Master Communicators are nominated and selected by their peers.
